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Beth,

I am attaching the signal warrant analysis for Tucker Station at BG Parkway and at S. Pope Lick Road, which shows that both signals are expected to meet signal warrants after the Ball Homes Residential Development and the Xebec development are completed. It does not contain the other developments in the area.

Below also is a table that shows the potential signal contribution based on the volume added to the intersection and an assumed signal cost of \$150K based on the methodology we discussed on Monday.
