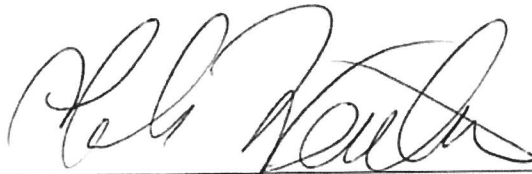

Our initial request to start the process was made two years ago, but due to the pandemic everything was delayed. Total = \$12,635.00

Please consider this letter as our official Statement of Cost for all speed hump related work. Each speed hump, including markings is \$2,215.00 and each sign is \$260.00. Based on our Engineering Studies, a total of five (5) speed humps and six (6) speed hump signs have been proposed for Huberta Drive, between Joy Drive and La Vel Lane. The total "not to exceed" cost is \$12,635.00.
