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

English Villa Drive is one of only two entrances for Wyndemere Patio Homes, the only residential community on English Villa Drive. There is currently a two-way stop for the intersection of English Villa and Wyndemere Drive, but with the increased traffic a drive-thru restaurant would bring to English Villa Drive a four-way stop is definitely warranted. Without a four-way stop, people in our community would find it extremely difficult to turn onto English Villa Drive during the restaurant's operating hours. There are sixteen homes on Charlton Wynde Drive which back up to English Villa Drive which will be affected by the increased traffic noise a drive-thru restaurant will create. This will most likely affect their property values in a negative way. Some type of noise abatement system needs to be put in place in order for those residents to maintain and insure the quality of living they have currently. The operating hours of a restaurant that close to peoples' property should be limited. The closing time should be no later than 9:00PM since this neighborhood is essentially made up of retired/elderly people. Essentially, this is not an ideal location for the existing residents. Last but not least, the traffic on Shelbyville Road in this area near I-265 is extremely heavy during the day.
