The estimated cost to install 36" white delineator posts at 6' spacing along the school frontage of W Southland Blvd (from S 3rd St to the stub entrance before residential properties) is \$29,568. Adding a 10% contingency the price is estimated to be \$33,000. Please let me know if you need anything else from me. We will accept these funds if Council's office would like to proceed with this project.

The pavement is 36' wide so we recommend installing them 6.5' off the curb to accommodate a 10' drive lane and 1.5' shy way (edge of travel lane to delineator post).

Thanks again for giving focus to the Southland Blvd parking issue. Below are the notes from our 10/3/22 meeting with Rutherford Elementary.

I. Heavy trucks

Per Dr. Natsis truck parking in front of Rutherford has consistently been a problem but has gotten worse in the last 4 years. Some of the semis completely disregard the existing signs. Some semis park on the weekends.

II. Impact

The impact of parking to the school is as follows:

- Blocking school entrance
- · Blocked visibility and cuts the school off from the community e.g. Community health fair
- Air quality near the playground
- School staff capacity to enforce
- Aesthetics and perception around the types of neighborhoods that allow this activity so close to a school

III. Past attempts to address

- Education to drivers (note many are not from the area and are only visiting)
- Engagement of the neighboring apartments and community leaders
- Calls to LMPD (over 30+ citations in January)
- JCPS calls to the superintendent

IV. Potential solutions

Note: Dr. Natsis stated that student pick up does not occur on Southland Blvd rather cars queue up in the back.

- Jeff suggested replacing the No Parking signs 7-4pm with No Parking Anytime signs- Done
- Jeff will estimate the cost of delineator posts to block the parking lane. Note this is expensive and may for the semis down the road. Pending
- Nicole will seek private funding to support the costs e.g. KY Trucking Association (?)
- Rebecca will save this documentation for continuity in the Council Office.
- Rutherford will continue to communicate updates on parking issues e.g. Are the new signs helping?
