### Amanda,

Louisville Metro Public Works has concluded our investigation for consideration of allowing Ramsey Middle School to install temporary stop signs at school start and dismissal times. We have reservations about doing this. As long as Ramsey is willing to meet some conditions we are willing to allow this on a temporary basis. First, the signs HAVE to be installed and removed in conjunction with the flasher times (6:55 AM to 7:55 AM and 2:05 PM to 3:05 PM). Second, we will require you to use 30" stop signs we will provide to the school to use free of charge. Third, you will have to agree to purchase and use the stop sign in a spring loaded stand for rigid signs (link to an option provided). Fourth, the signs and posts need to be outside of the right of way on weekends and extended periods of time school is not in session. Fifth, Ramsey Middle School has to permit LMPW to install a new traffic pattern ahead warning sign on school property.

Please let me know if you are comfortable with these conditions and we will schedule a rush project to install (4) new traffic pattern ahead warning signs on all approaches.

To clarify, are you requesting that a stop sign be added as you leave the Carrithers Middle School campus, or are you requesting stop signs be added to the drive lanes (north and south) on Billtown Rd.? If the request is to have JCPS install on campus we can have that completed ASAP. If the sign is needed on Billtown Rd. metro's signs and markings will have to make that determination.

If the post is suspected to be vacant for a prolonged period of time we could also work with J-town PD as they are very receptive to placing uniform officers if they are available. If J-town PD were made aware that the post was to be vacant for a prolonged period of time they may be able to flex staff ahead of time instead of trying to pull daily at the last minute...Just a thought.

As a possible temporary solution, is it possible to have temporary stop signs placed at Ramsey Middle School to help control and assist motorists entering and exiting the school? We have also received a complaint regarding overgrown trees that are blocking the line of sight of motorists as they enter/exit the school driveway. Our office has contacted Metro311 regarding the overgrown trees.
