Council President James called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

#### **Moment of Silence**

Council President James stated the number of people who have died (1,922) and the number of diagnosed cases (206,193) of COVID-19 as of that morning in Louisville. He stated that Louisville remains in the Red Zone but the number of cases has declined.

Council President James commemorated Curtis White, Sophia White's brother, who passed away after a long illness and was buried with full military honor in recognition of his military service. He also commemorated Delores Triplett, Council Member Triplett's mother, who recently passed, and had served the Louisville community for over 29 years in the Legislative and Administrative branches of government. He asked that everyone join him in a moment of silence.
