**WHEREAS,** Louisville Metro Government wishes to make an application for United States Department of Homeland Security and/or Commonwealth of Kentucky funds for a project to be administered by the Kentucky Office of Homeland Security through the Louisville Metro Police Department; and

**WHEREAS,** it is recognized that an application for and approval of the Kentucky Office of

Homeland Security funds impose certain obligations and responsibilities upon the city.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION I:** The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute and furnish all required documents, including a memorandum of agreement, as may be required by KOHS for the furtherance of the above referenced project and to act as the authorized correspondent for said project.

**SECTION II:** The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept up to \$277,000 from the Kentucky Office of Homeland Security to purchase a rehab and response vehicle to supplement LMPD's chemical, radiological, and nuclear response capabilities.

**SECTION III:** This Resolution shall become effective upon its passage and approval or otherwise becoming law.
