BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT (THE "COUNCIL") AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: The sum of \$12,500 \$17,500 is hereby appropriated from Neighborhood Development Funds in the following manner: \$12,500 from District 8; and \$5,000 from District 9, through the Office of Management and Budget, to Highland Commerce Guild for materials and labor costs for its Graffiti Abatement and Clean Up Program.
