ORDINANCE NO, SERIES 2022 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$10,000 FROM DISTRICT 26 NEIGHBORHOOD DEVELOPMENT FUNDS TO THE LOUISVILLE METRO POLICE DEPARTMEN ("LMPD") TO FUND ADDITIONAL HOURS FOR LMPD OFFICERS TO PROVID SPEEDING AND CRIME PREVENTION IN DISTRICT 26 DURING THE HOLIDA'S SEASON. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSOICOUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT (THE "COUNCIL") AS FOLLOWS:

expended for a public purpose.
SECTION III: This grant is subject to the Council's Policies and Procedures as adopted an
