

These are the up to date bids for stucco work from Schnurr and painting from Pollard. Let me know when I can contact them to get on their schedules this fall.

We are working with someone on paint colors. Pollard has used Sherwin Williams on our houses, but I don't know yet what might be suggested by colorist. I'll keep you posted!

A crew has removed the termite damaged flooring in the sunroom, however there has still been no treatment to kill any remaining and prevent recurrence. I don't think there was any inspection of the wood in walls under and around the windows. A piece of baseboard was riddled under one. Photos are from floor which was covered with multiple layers of wood with active termites into each layer. Would hate to have wood between plaster and stucco be devoured by them. Crew did nice job replacing floor and replacing concrete covering over old coal chute.
