AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING ~~\$10,300~~ \$11,550 FROM NEIGHBORHOOD DEVELOPMENT FUNDS IN THE FOLLOWING MANNER: \$4,000 FROM DISTRICT 22; \$2,000 FROM DISTRICT 19; \$1,500 FROM DISTRICT 13; \$550 FROM DISTRICT 11; \$500 EACH FROM DISTRICTS 6, 10, 15, 20, AND 21; AND \$250 EACH FROM DISTRICTS 3, 12, ~~AND 16, AND 23~~; THROUGH THE OFFICE OF MANAGEMENT AND BUDGET, TO JUNIOR ACHIEVEMENT OF KENTUCKIANA, INC. FOR CURRICULUM MATERIALS FOR ITS FINANCIAL LITERACY, CAREER READINESS, AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP PROGRAMS (AS AMENDED).

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT (THE "COUNCIL") AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: The sum of ~~\$10,300~~ \$11,550 is hereby appropriated from Neighborhood Development Funds in the following manner: \$4,000 from District 22; \$2,000 from District 19; \$1,500 from District 13; \$550 from District 11; \$500 each from Districts 6, 10, 15, 20, and 21; and \$250 each from Districts 3, 12, ~~and 16, and 23~~; through the Office of Management and Budget, to Junior Achievement of Kentuckiana, Inc. for curriculum materials for its financial literacy, career readiness, and entrepreneurship programs.

SECTION II: The Council has determined the funds requested in this Ordinance will be expended for a public purpose.

SECTION III: This grant is subject to the Council's Policies and Procedures as adopted and effective at the date of passage of this Ordinance.

SECTION IV: This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and approval or otherwise becoming law.
