Please consider this letter as our official Statement of Cost for all speed hump related work. Each speed hump, including markings is \$2,215.00 and each sign is \$260.00. Based on our Engineering Studies, a total of two (2) speed humps and two (2) speed hump signs have been proposed for Dodge Lane, between Valley Station Road and Dodge Court. The total "not to exceed" cost is \$4,950.00.
