Vision Statement: Through planning, research, and system-wide coordination, the Criminal Justice Commission strives to create a fair and equitable criminal justice system.

- **Goal # 1:** Explore collaboration with the Racial Fairness Commission in 2022

Key Performance Indicators

Goal #1 KPI: Number of RFC meetings held in 2022

The Racial Fairness Commission has met five times to plan the project. Meetings were held on the following dates: April 14th, May 19th, June 23rd, July 21st, and September 14th. The next meeting is scheduled for October 11, 2022.



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- **Goal #2:** Disaggregate criminal justice system data by demographics (race, ethnicity, gender and age) in 2022

Key Performance Indicator

Goal #2 KPI: Criminal justice system data disaggregated by demographics in 2022

Jail Population Management Dashboard – to provide granular, near real-time data about the jail population and will allow users to compute jail population statistics disaggregated by race, gender, age, jail status, court status, bail, and length of stay



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- **Goal #3:** Continue to participate in the Annie E. Casey Juvenile Detention Alternatives Initiative with the goal to reduce racial and ethnic disparities within the juvenile justice system in FY 23

Key Performance Indicator

Goal #3 KPI: Number of JJAC meetings held in FY 23
