

ORDINANCE NO. 193, SERIES 2022

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$10,000 FROM DISTRICT 26 NEIGHBORHOOD DEVELOPMENT FUNDS TO THE LOUISVILLE METRO POLICE DEPARTMENT (“LMPD”) TO FUND ADDITIONAL HOURS FOR LMPD OFFICERS TO PROVIDE SPEEDING AND CRIME PREVENTION IN DISTRICT 26 DURING THE HOLIDAY SEASON.


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT (THE “COUNCIL”) AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: The sum of \$10,000 is hereby appropriated from District 26 Neighborhood Development Funds to the Louisville Metro Police Department (“LMPD”) to fund additional hours for LMPD officers to provide speeding and crime prevention in District 26 during the holiday season.


SECTION II: The Council has determined the funds requested in this Ordinance will be expended for a public purpose.

SECTION III: This grant is subject to the Council’s Policies and Procedures as adopted and effective at the date of passage of this Ordinance.


SECTION IV: This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and approval or otherwise becoming law.

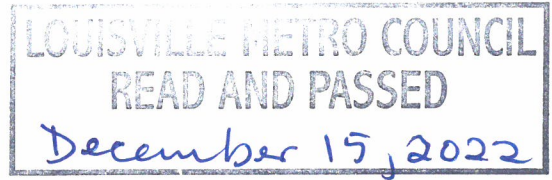
