Hello all,

Thank you for looping me in Theresa. And thank you Elizabeth for sharing all the great information about our Little Free Libraries (LFLs).

Metro United Way has a network of 42 LFLs that we maintain and fill with books — books are donated by individuals, local companies, corporate book drives, book stores such as Half Price Books and Barnes and Noble, etc. We are proud to say that we have placed over 160,000 books in our libraries since we started thanks to our community partners and individual donors. We have a community of library hosts that allow LFLs to sit in their front yards and be shared with their neighbors. We also have a fantastic group of volunteer book runners that pick up books from MUW every two weeks and deliver to 36 of those libraries (the other 6 provide books on their own). I have attached a list of where all our LFLs are located for reference — locations were chosen primarily based on lowest reading rates for children attending JCPS schools in 2014 when we started our program. Although there are LFLs all over the county, we at MUW do not host or fill all of them.

To answer the question below, physical library boxes are available for purchase through this page — <a href="https://littlefreelibrary.myshopify.com/">https://littlefreelibrary.myshopify.com/</a> for \$270 - \$370 each. We were lucky enough to have several of our libraries built by a couple different local companies — we only paid for materials for these. We often hear from community members wanting to host a LFL in their front yard but unfortunately, we do not have the allocated funds to provide libraries for them. We typically refer them to the National Little Free Library organization website's build page, <a href="https://littlefreelibrary.org/build/">https://littlefreelibrary.org/build/</a>, to view their recommended library building plans or we send them our library building plans (attached) so they can build their own.

I hope this information is helpful. We would love to partner with BookWorks and Metro Council on a project to bring more Little Libraries to our community. Please keep us in the loop to see how we can help!
