

ORDINANCE NO. _____, SERIES 2022

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE DECISION OF THE PLANNING COMMISSION TO APPROVE THE REVISED DISTRICT DEVELOPMENT PLAN PROPOSED IN CASE NO. 22-DDP-0098 FOR THE PROPERTY LOCATED AT 13905 AIKEN ROAD. (AS AMENDED)

WHEREAS, the Legislative Council of the Louisville/Jefferson County Metro Government (the “Council”) has reviewed the evidence presented at the public hearing held by the Louisville Metro Planning Commission (the “Planning Commission”) and the findings and decision of the Planning Commission as set out in the minutes and records of the Planning Commission in Case No. 22-DDP-0098 for the property located at 13905 Aiken Road; and

WHEREAS, the Council concurs in and adopts the findings of the Planning Commission for the revised district development plan in Case No. 22-DDP-0098 and approves and accepts the decision of the Planning Commission as set out in said minutes and records, with the addition of a binding element.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT (THE “COUNCIL”) AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: That the revised district development plan for the property located at 13905 Aiken Road and being in Louisville Metro, as more particularly described in the minutes and records of the Planning Commission in Case No. 22-DDP-0098, is hereby approved, with an additional binding element:-

16. Any significant increases to the proposed structures (e.g. increases in building height, number of units, number of buildings), any increase in density on the property, any changes in use on the property which directly or indirectly require a public hearing before the Planning Commission or

subcommittee thereof, and/or any amendments to the binding elements, other than (i) the addition of new binding elements, (ii) changes to binding elements that merely update the public hearing date, or (iii) updating a previous version of this binding element to reflect the current language, shall be reviewed before the Planning Commission with final action to be determined by Metro Council.

SECTION II: This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and approval or otherwise becoming law.
