AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 42 OF THE LOUISVILLE METRO CODE OF ORDINANCES REGARDING USE OF METRO OWNED PARKS.

SPONSORED BY: COUNCIL MEMBERS SHANKLIN, FOWLER, GEORGE, HOLTON STEWART, AND PRESIDENT JAMES

WHEREAS, Metro Parks are regularly used for events by non-governmental organizations and private citizens; and

WHEREAS, use of the parks for events entails additional certain costs for which

the Department of Parks charges reasonable fees, including but not limited to fees for the

use of Metro-owned property and equipment and costs of security necessary for the event

provided by LMPD; and

WHEREAS, Louisville Metro Government offices regularly sponsor official events

for the community which are held in the Louisville Metro Parks system, many of which

have been held annually for many years; and

WHEREAS, the departmental budgets are created by Louisville Metro Government with the understanding and expectation that Metro agencies may use Metro Parks properties for official events, as they have in the past, and funding for LMPD and Parks takes that into account.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: A new section of Chapter 42 shall provide as follows:

SECTION 42.33. FEES ASSOCIATED WITH USE OF PARK PROPERTY AND EQUIPMENT.

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Louisville Metro Government may charge reasonable fees associated with the use of Metro-owned park property and equipment, including but not limited to fees required for additional security for the event. Non-governmental organizations and private residents shall be responsible for payment of all fees associated with a rental of Metroowned park property. No Metro office or agency shall be charged such fees in connection with any official Metro government event; provided, however, any Metro official seeking to use Metro-owned park property for any other purpose shall be responsible for all applicable fees.

SECTION II: This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and approval or otherwise becoming law.
