FOR PROGRAMMING EXPENSES ASSOCIATED WITH PROJECT STAND DOWN.

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT (THE "COUNCIL") AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: The sum of $\$ 10,000$ is hereby appropriated from Neighborhood Development Funds in the following manner: \$1,000 each from Districts 9, 10, 12, 13, and 24; $\$ 500$ each from Districts $6,14,15,17,19,20,22,23$, and 25 ; and $\$ 250$ each from Districts 3 and 21; through the Office of Management and Budget, to the Coalition for the Homeless, Inc. for programming expenses associated with Project Stand Down.

SECTION II: The Council has determined the funds requested in this Ordinance will be expended for a public purpose.

SECTION III: This grant is subject to the Council's Policies and Procedures as adopted and effective at the date of passage of this Ordinance.

SECTION IV: This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and approval or otherwise becoming law.
