Brian,

At this time, Louisville Metro Public Works doesn't have the resources to install reflective pavement markers (RPM). Currently, there is no budget to install pavement markings or RPMs. We take \$100,000 directly from our Signs and Markings materials budget to refresh pavement markings. Out of the over estimated 400 linear miles of marked roadway we are responsible for this allows us to restripe approximately 25 miles annually. Also, we recently received proposed pricing increases from our contractor of over 30% which will lessen the amount of roadways we are able to refresh annually.

There are some roadways we have installed RPMs recently due to being funded by the Councilperson. If CW Stewart's office would like a cost estimate to install this treatment please let me know and I can work on providing one.
