

Jeff –

This SR# has been entered into Accela for an accident which occurred on 03/27/2022. Whatever input I made sent this to Parks but it isn't a Parks issue; it is a PW issue. A car took out some landscaping in place at the NE corner of Manner Dale and Breckenridge Lane and then went on to take out an iron railing which PW has installed within the last year. This intersection used to be in CM Kramer's district but is now in Brent's.

The car was stolen and there is probably no way to recover any costs involved for improvements. However, we want to move on redoing the landscaping and rebuilding the iron railing. I know there was some discussion on how that would be paid for when that was in the 11<sup>th</sup> District, and that it took a long time to get it done. At this time, we will pay for the costs of rebuilding the railing and the landscaping costs from the 26<sup>th</sup> CIF account.

Please tell me what I need to do to proceed as soon as possible.
