Total = \$6,550.00

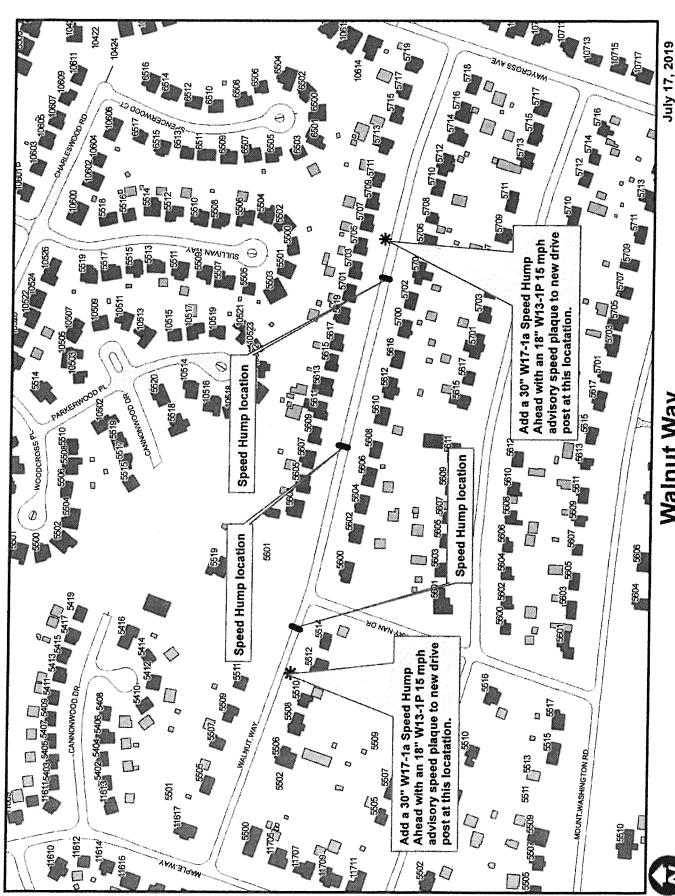
