CONSTRUCTION REVIEW

- Building Permits, Plan Review & Inspections
- Electrical Permits & Inspections
- HVAC Permits & Inspections
- Issued 4,586 Building Permits FY18 to date
- Issued 11,818 HVAC Permits FY18 to date
- Issued 9,908 Electrical Permits FY18 to date
- Division performed over 52,587 inspections FY18 to date

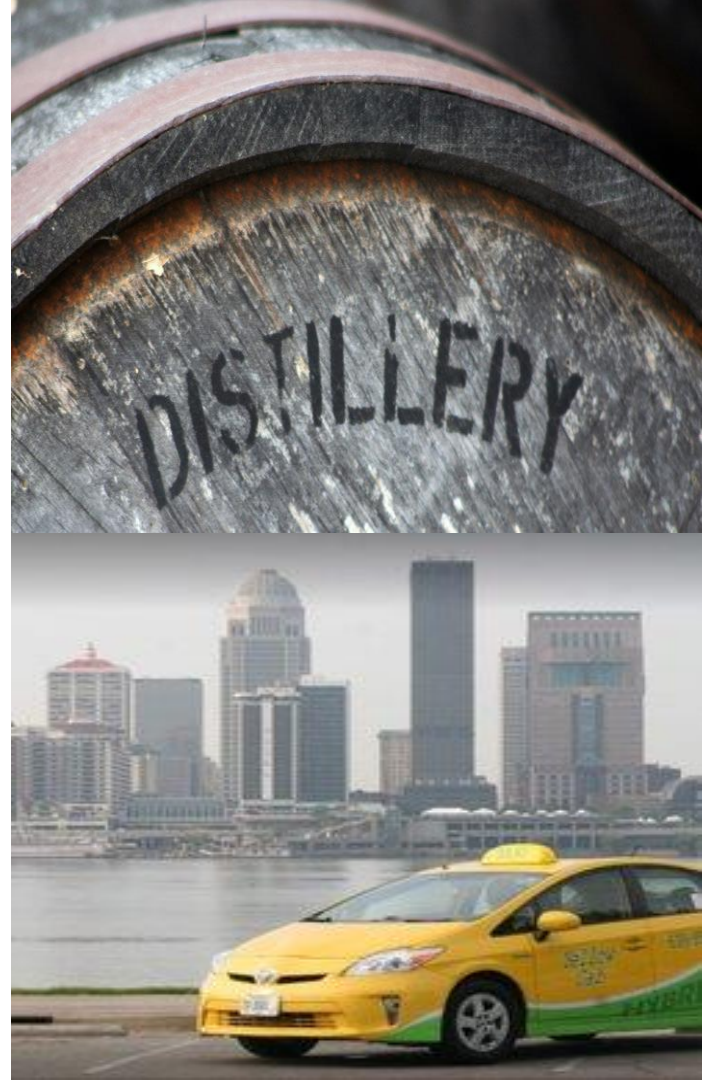

PROPERTY MAINTENANCE

- Responds to 311 service requests regarding Property Maintenance Code concerns
- Conducts Section 8/HQS inspections for LMHA
- Customer Service team schedules hearings and maintains Code Enforcement Board records
- Performed more than 58,000 PM Inspections FY18 to date
- Performed more than 17,500 HQS inspections FY18 to date
- Held more than 1,450 Code Enforcement Board appeal hearings
- 3,575 rental property owners registered in FY18



VACANT LOTS

- Division abates property maintenance violation referrals on vacant properties (Boarding & Cleanings)
- Maintains over 500 Metro controlled vacant lots
- Vacant lots completed 15,613 boarding and cleaning work orders FY18 to date
- Abates graffiti on vacant & public property
- Responsible for 10 assigned Metro snow routes



GRAFFITI CREW

- Responds to graffiti referrals from Code Enforcement Officers in response to 311 complaints on private vacant properties
- Resource for partner agencies (Facilities, Public Works, Parks, etc.) as needed to assist with graffiti abatement
- Monitors and abates reoccurring identified graffiti hotspots/high traffic entryways to Metro
- Graffiti team has abated 661 graffiti cases FY18 to date
- 428 open graffiti violations on private property
