

The estimate for Service Request # 4580687 & # 4573119 sidewalk project (in front of 1435 Rosewood Ave.). The current sidewalk stops midway thru the front of their property. To carry new 6' sidewalk thru the rest of the property the total cost would be approx. \$2,900. The costs all include 40' of new 6' wide concrete sidewalk and grass seeding & protection and contingencies for anything unforeseen.
