Proposed Streetscape Component Costs

- 6 Trash Receptacles @ \$800 each = **\$4800**
- 2 New Street Signs @ \$188 each = **\$376**
- 17 replacements of various signs = **\$4690**
- Cut 1 New Tree Well, Enlarge 2 Others = **\$1000**
- Plant 3 Trees, Bags & Water for 3 years = **\$ 1845**
- 2 Bike Racks @ \$500 each = **\$1000**
- Upgrade 6 Cobra Lights to LED @ \$450 each = **\$2700**
- Fresh Paint crosswalk boxes, sign posts and hydrant = **\$750**
- New crosswalks, stop bars & lane assignment markings = **\$6,600**
- Concept, Design, Project Management 30 hrs @ \$125/hr - **\$3750**

Total - \$27,511

with public space streetscape improvements.

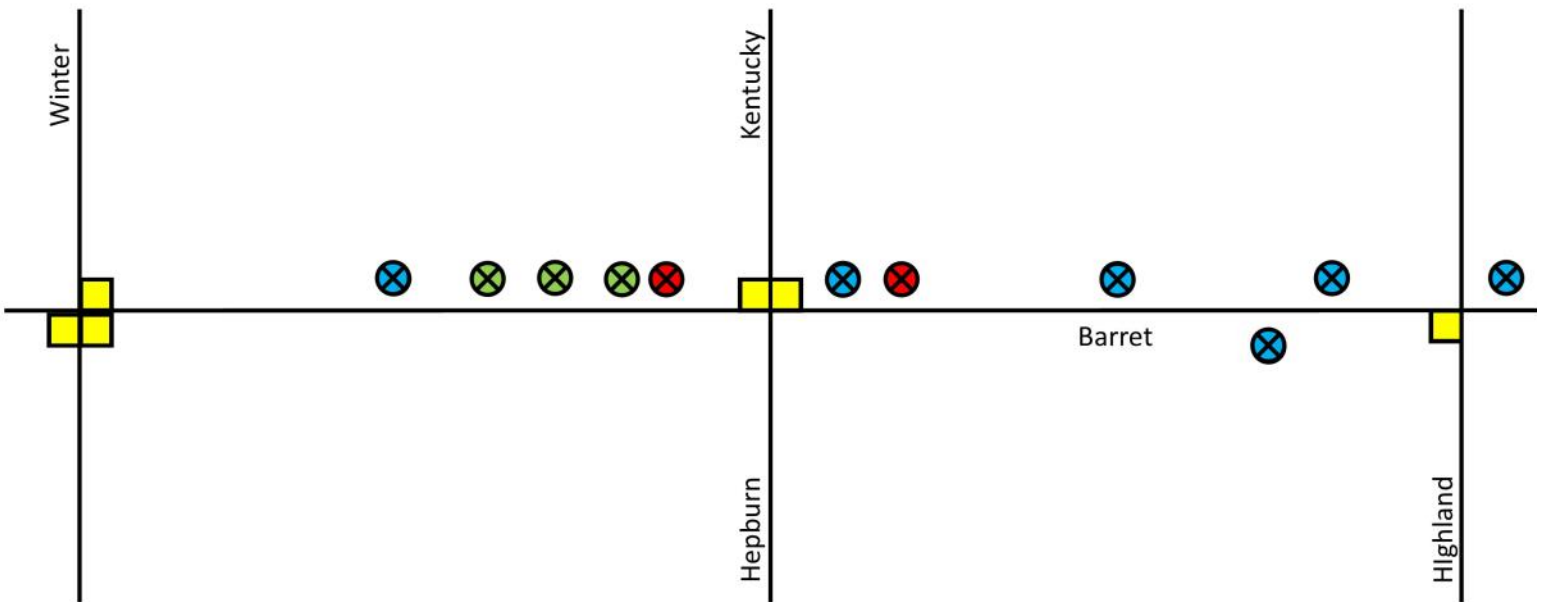

Jeff,

As you know, Ken Herndon (copied here) has helped us put together a streetscape improvement plan for Barret Ave btw Winter and Highland. This includes a number of features all vetted by Public Works (and others like Urban Forestry and LGE), including a crosswalks and road markings refresh vetted by Stuart.

The final plan does NOT include banners and it uses standard black (instead of blue) litter bins with the neighborhood names, which are changes from previous plan drafts you may have seen.

Please see attached final plan/budget and confirm that Public Works will accept D8 CIF in the amount of \$27,511 to implement the plan. If you have any questions or want to discuss, we can set up a conference call with Ken and whoever else would be helpful. I know you keep good notes but may need reminders about which street signs or lights are being replaced, etc.

Once you say we're good to go, then Jasmine will initiate transfer of funds. I trust Ken will help with oversight until the project is completed.
