

• Playground Concerns

- moving to bottom causes issues with younger children + ADA accessibility
- Want separate parks to segregate ages + "behaviors"
- issues with bathrooms being so close to playground b/c of homeless population taking shelter there.

• tennis court concerns / Sport Courts
