Join us for the **2015 Kentucky Alliance Unity Movement Dinner** on Saturday, December 12 at the Kentucky Center for African American Heritage located at 1701 West Muhammad Ali Blvd. Our keynote speaker will be Pamela J. Meanes, the current President of the National Bar Association.

Ms. Meanes was the first African American to become a partner in St. Louis' largest law firm Thompson Coburn. She also holds an honorary Doctorate of Divinity and is an ordained minister at the new Freedom Church in Belleville, IL. She was one of the leading legal voices speaking out about how the prosecutor handled the grand jury in the murder of Michael Brown in Ferguson, MO by Darren Wilson.

The evening will start with the "Social Justice Hour" from 6:00 until 7:00pm featuring groups around the community working for change. The Unity Dinner will follow from 7:00 until 9:00pm. In addition to hearing from Ms. Meanes, we will be honoring Nana Yaa Asantewaa, a.k.a. "Mama Yaa" with the Carl and Anne Braden Lifetime Achievement Award. We will also be honoring James Leavell with the Albert Caples Prison Abolition Award. Other Honorees include Edgardo Mansilla and Linda Omer.
