

Two (2) Speed Hump signs x \$260.00 = 520.00
Total = \$8,920.00

Please consider this letter as our official Statement of Cost for all speed hump related work. Each speed hump, including markings is \$2,800.00 and each sign is \$260.00. Based on our Engineering Studies, a total of three (3) speed humps and two (2) speed hump signs have been proposed for Virginia Avenue between S. 43rd Street and Southwestern Parkway. The total "not to exceed" cost is \$8,920.00.

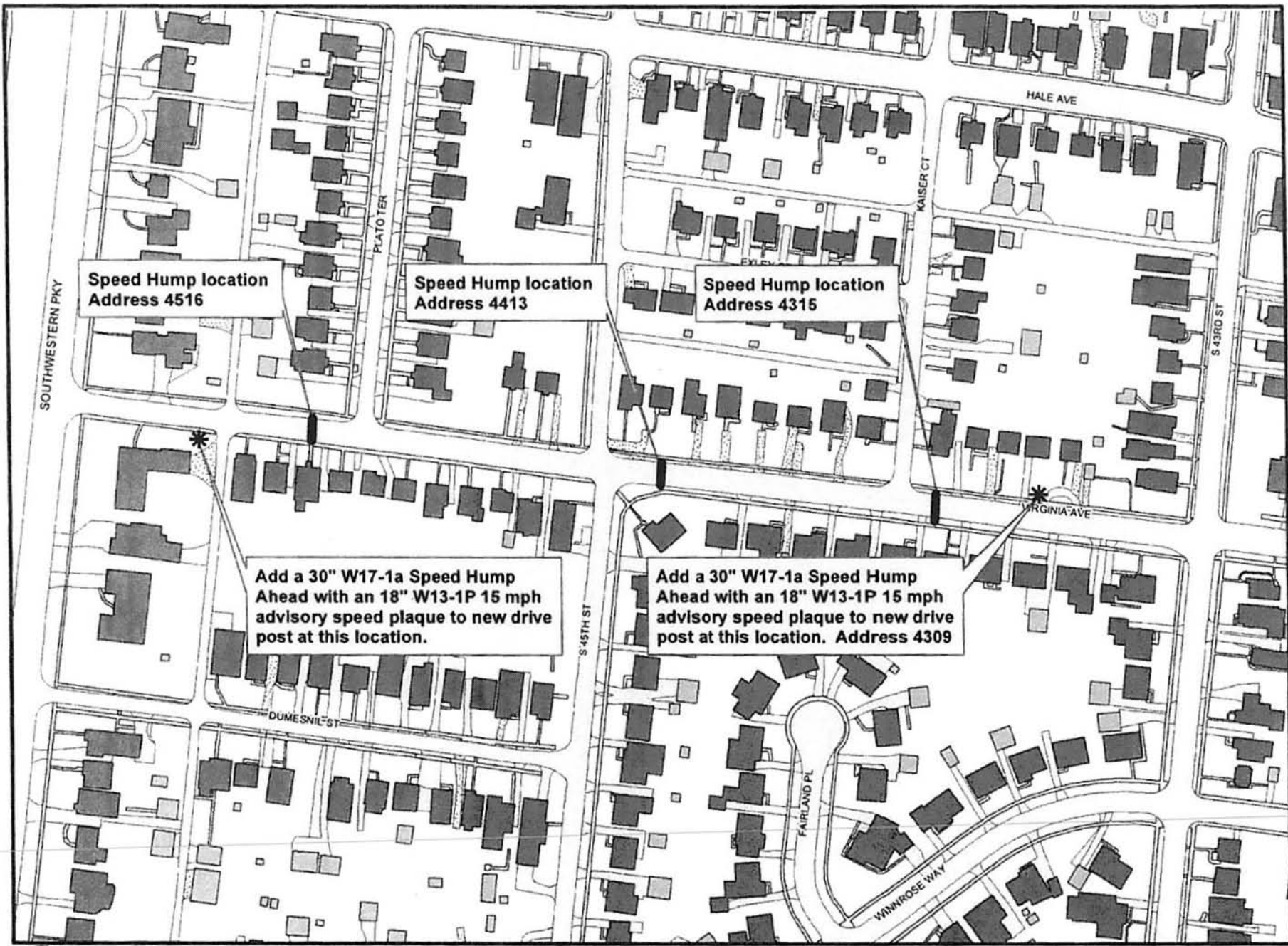
The reason for the \$2,800.00 per speed hump cost is because Virginia Avenue is approximately 31-32 ft. in width. Any street width over 30 ft., the cost will be \$2,800.00 as appose to the normal cost of \$2,050.00.

Upon funding approval, the speed humps will be installed as schedule and weather permits.
