Re: *Request for Annexation Approval; Jeffersontown Ordinance No. 1318, Series 2014*

Dear Mr. Ott:

Please find enclosed a copy of Jeffersontown Ordinance No. 1318, Series 2014, requesting the approval of Metro Council to annex a certain area commonly known as Chenoweth Hills Estates. This area is a subdivision of 143 single family homes, and includes no businesses. Its only primary access street enters the City of Jeffersontown and therefore, all of these homes cannot be accessed other than by going through the City of Jeffersontown. This area was developed during the moratorium on annexation. Therefore, only now has the City of Jeffersontown been in a position to provide them the services which their neighbors receive, and which these residents almost unanimously seek.

I have also enclosed a series of documents providing responses to the various categories of information which Metro Council requests in considering the approval of annexations. I am enclosing them as I am unclear whether these should be considered a part of the Requesting Ordinance or as supplementary information. Please treat them appropriately as required by your protocols. By all means they are to be forwarded to Councilman Downard and all members of the Annexation Committee.

ORDINANCE NO. 1318, SERIES 2014

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO REQUESTING THE APPROVAL BY THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO COUNCIL OF THE ANNEXATION BY THE CITY OF JEFFERSONTOWN OF A TRACT OF LAND COMMONLY KNOWN AS CHENOWETH HILLS ESTATES, WHICH LAND IS CONTIGUOUS WITH THE EXISTING BOUNDARY OF THE CITY OF JEFFERSONTOWN, BUT NOT CONTIGUOUS TO THE BOUNDARY OF THE FORMER CITY OF LOUISVILLE, AND BEING IN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF THE FORMER COUNTY OF JEFFERSON

WHEREAS, the City of Jeffersontown seeks to annex the following described tracts of land (with improvements) which tracts are not contiguous with the boundary of the former City of Louisville; and

WHEREAS, nearly Ninety-five Percent (95%) of the property owners residing within the annexation area have executed their written consent to the subject annexation by the City of Jeffersontown; and

WHEREAS, the City of Jeffersontown is ready and able to immediately begin furnishing municipal services to the area upon annexation of the area; and

WHEREAS, KRS 67C.111 requires that the annexation receive the approval of the legislative council of the consolidated local government (the Louisville/Jefferson County Metro City Council) prior to the City proceeding under the provisions of KRS Chapter 81A;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF JEFFERSONTOWN, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City of Jeffersontown hereby seeks and requests the approval of the Louisville/Jefferson County Metro Council of the annexation of that certain property being the Estates of Chenoweth Hills Subdivision recorded in Plat Book 42, Pages 2 and 3, and Plat Book 44, Page 62, along with that certain property of record at Deed Book 08694, Page 271, all of record within the Office of the Clerk of Jefferson County, Kentucky.

Section 3. The individual parcels identified collectively in Section 1 are contiguous with one another, and are collectively contiguous with the City of Jeffersontown and are urban in character. The owners of nearly all of the parcels have consented in writing to the requested annexation.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect upon its adoption and publication as required by law.

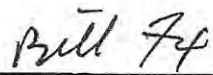

MEMORANDUM

TO: LOUISVILLE METRO COUNCIL

RE: REQUEST FOR APPROVAL OF ANNEXATION

DATE: NOVEMBER 11, 2014

This Memorandum is respectfully submitted on behalf of the City of Jeffersontown, Kentucky, in order to provide supplementary information with regard to Jeffersontown's effort to annex the area known as Chenoweth Hills Estates, a residential subdivision which is contiguous to the southern boundary of Jeffersontown. Attached to this Memorandum are various exhibits relative to the Request.

A. The Nature of the Area to be Annexed.

Attached to this Memorandum as **Exhibit A** is the certified survey and property description of the property to be annexed. As you will see, this area of 49.550 acres is comprised of 143 single family homes. It is currently contiguous to the City of Jeffersontown, and not a part of any other incorporated municipality. It is entirely urban residential in character, and contains no industrial, commercial, or agricultural properties. Nearly 1100 feet of the area currently abuts the existing city limits. The only access into and out of the area is via Chenwood Lane, which continues into the existing City of Jeffersontown. Therefore, at this time every resident of the area must pass through the City of Jeffersontown in order to reach schools, work, hospitals, shopping, restaurants and entertainment. Any services currently provided to them by Metro Louisville must first come through the City of Jeffersontown. Of course, the same holds true for utilities and garbage collection. Given this close and integral proximity to the City, Jeffersontown is uniquely situated to immediately provide all municipal services to this area as soon as the annexation would become effective.

Also, the area to be annexed is the second phase of the entire Chenoweth Hills subdivision. The first phase is within the City of Jeffersontown, and receives Jeffersontown

services, including garbage pickup and snow removal. The area to be annexed was developed soon after the first moratorium on annexation went into effect. Thus, these residents are asking to accomplish what had been intended since the initial development of their neighborhood, and which would have been accomplished but for the first and second moratoriums.

B. Residential Support for the Annexation.

The steps taken to explore this annexation have been methodical and deliberate. The effort began by residents contacting the City to explore the possibility of annexation. At the request of the City, the Homeowners Association of the area sent notice of a public meeting to all of the residents, and the Association held that meeting on June 26, 2014 at the Jeffersontown Fire Protection District Community Room. Several Jeffersontown Council members, and Mayor Dieruf attended this meeting. In the course of the meeting, Jeffersontown asked that the Homeowners Association circulate a petition expressing residents' support for the annexation. On July 28, 2013, the petition was given to Jeffersontown by David Wilson and Don Perry, the President and Vice President, respectively, of the Homeowners Association. A true copy of the petition is attached hereto as **Exhibit B**. The original copy is retained in the records of Jeffersontown. By virtue of this petition, 94.6 per cent of the residents expressed their support to become citizens of Jeffersontown.

Following the June meeting, various departments of Jeffersontown city government were accessed to give opinions as to feasibility and potential costs to the city were the annexation to proceed. Based upon these evaluations, the city is convinced that the additional cost of city services—police, EMS, drainage, street paving and maintenance, sidewalk maintenance, garbage and waste pickup, snow removal, sign installation and maintenance, and street lights, along with other ancillary minor services—will be reasonably offset by property taxes and insurance premium taxes paid by the new residents. Because of their close proximity to the city, there does not appear to be a need to add staff in any department of city government, including police. Certainly, even if the cost of services were to exceed revenues generated, any excess would not have a material impact on the budget of the city, or the ability of the city to provide its current level of city services to existing residents of the city.

Thereafter, the City sent notice to the residents of the proposed area by first class mail of a meeting to be held in Council Chambers on Tuesday, September 23, 2014 in the evening. The notice sent to them, dated September 4, 2014, is attached as **Exhibit C**. As you will see, this notice (signed by Mayor Dieruf) sets forth the tax rates as well as list of specific city services they will receive should the annexation be successful.

A roster of the persons attending is attached as **Exhibit D**. The meeting was led by Mayor Dieruf, and members of the City Council attended along with members of staff. Councilman Benson also attended and participated. The meeting lasted approximately ninety minutes, and discussions were held regarding tax rates, benefits of annexation, annexation

procedures, and the findings of the city regarding feasibility. Only one person attending the meeting left the meeting still expressing reservation to the annexation.

Interestingly, several residents expressed that they grew up in Jeffersontown and thought they were still in Jeffersontown when they moved to Chenoweth Hills. These people expressed disappointment they had when they learned that they were not in the city. Others looked forward to enhanced police and ambulance service in the sense that it made them feel more secure. Others expressed a desire to have greater access to government, even though they simultaneously voiced strong support and appreciation for the service provided them by Councilman Benson.

Following this meeting, proposed Ordinances were prepared. The residents were given notice of the City Council meeting to be held on October 7, 2014, where the two Ordinances pertaining to the Annexation (the Ordinance expressing intent to annex and the Ordinance requesting the approval of Metro Council) would be given first reading. This notice was sent via certified mail, return receipt requested. A copy of the notice and a roster of the addresses to which it was sent are attached hereto as **Exhibit E**. One hundred thirty six cards were returned signed out of 143 households. No opposition was heard at the meeting. The Ordinance requesting Metro Council approval was given second reading at the regular meeting of the City Council on October 21, 2014, and that Ordinance passed unanimously. Second reading of the Ordinance declaring intent to annex will not occur until and unless Metro Council approval is given.

C. Impact upon Metro Government.

The economic impact to Metro Government will be felt in three areas. First, road fund receipts we estimate will be reduced by \$7, 383.67 annually, based upon the U.S. Census mean of 2.2 persons per household and a current rate of \$23.47 per person. According to the Louisville Metro budget, this amounts to a loss of four one-hundredths of one percent (00.04%).

The second impact will be in loss of insurance tax receipts for 143 households. Using an assumed total taxable premium of \$1800 per household per annum, this amounts to \$12, 870 annual reduction in Metro Government receipts. This equals twenty four thousandths of one percent (00.024 %) of insurance premium tax receipts.

The third impact will be in a loss of the proposed natural gas surcharge. It is impossible for us to project this with certainty, but given that these are relatively newer homes with modern HVAC equipment and in generally good repair, we believe that receipts from these residents would be negligible.

D. Conclusion.

The Chenoweth Hills neighborhood strongly favors annexation by Jeffersontown and, because of the physical location of it to Jeffersontown, the city is fully equipped to immediately begin providing them with the services that their neighbors currently enjoy. For years, they have

self-identified as being residents of Jeffersontown, and annexation will make that a reality for them. In this year's budget, on page 12, Metro Louisville identified its first objective to "deliver excellent city services." Jeffersontown is immediately capable of providing "excellent city services to these residents, who are and will remain citizens of Metro Louisville. Thus, approval of this annexation may be seen as an innovative and creative way of meeting Mayor Fischer's first objective, and fulfilling the hopes and desires of a neighborhood. Yes, there will be a cost to Metro Louisville in terms of lost revenues that will transfer to Jeffersontown. But those revenues will still be fully expended for the benefit of Metro Louisville citizens, and because of the proximity of Jeffersontown to them, those tax dollars can be applied very cost-effectively. Without question, even if Metro Louisville desired to extend the same level of services to Chenoweth Hills that they will receive from Jeffersontown, the cost to do so would be astronomical. And Metro Government employees would still have to drive through Jeffersontown to reach these people.

Often, the best governing results when governments act cooperatively and collectively. This is one situation where that result will immediately follow. For example, on page 13 of the Metro Budget, Louisville Metro points to bringing on 96 police recruits to enhance public safety. By approving this annexation request, Metro Council will immediately bring 70 fully trained, experienced Jeffersontown police officers into the service of these residents. In return, those 96 recruits will be freed up to provide additional service to the remainder of Jefferson County. This is but one of several examples that could be cited. In the end, it makes perfect sense for the residents of Chenoweth Hills to become citizens of Jeffersontown. And if it makes sense, common wisdom teaches us that the initiative should move forward, and the request to annex should be approved.

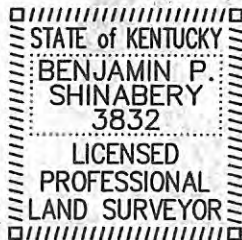

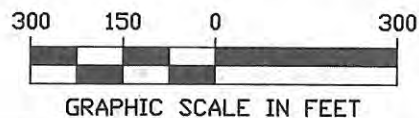

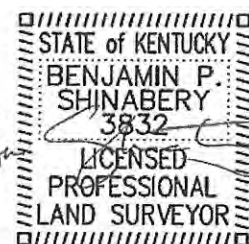
