AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$5,500 FROM DISTRICT 7 NEIGHBORHOOD DEVELOPMENT FUNDS, THROUGH THE OFFICE OF MANAGEMENT AND BUDGET, TO THE AMERICAN NATIONAL RED CROSS, LOUISVILLE AREA CHAPTER, FOR EXPENSES ASSOCIATED WITH THE HOME FIRE CAMPAIGN AND "SOUND THE ALARM, SAVE A LIFE" PROGRAM.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT (THE COUNCIL) AS FOLLOWS:

**SECTION I:** The amount of \$5,500 is hereby appropriated from District 7 Neighborhood Development Funds, through the Office of Management and Budget, to The American National Red Cross, Louisville Area Chapter, for expenses associated with purchasing smoke alarms for the Home Fire Campaign and "Sound the Alarm, Save a Life" Program, a program dedicated to increasing home fire safety.

**SECTION II:** The Council has determined the funds requested in this Ordinance will be expended for a public purpose.

**SECTION III:** This grant is subject to the Council's Policies and Procedures as adopted and effective at the date of passage of this Ordinance.
