

Denise,

On 8/2/18, Kevin Vittitow at 348 N 27th St called and advised us that some lights were not working in the alley behind his home and that people were dumping trash there.

We repaired the 4 Metro paid lights in the alley. Kevin wanted to have a light installed on the pole behind his house to deter people from dumping trash. I told him he could have a light installed and pay for it after signing a five year contract. He wanted the city to pay for a light. He contacted Sherry Hamilton's office and Chase Sanders, her assistant, called me to get info. I emailed him a Lighting Brochure on 9/11/18. Kevin called me on 9/13/18 and I told him I had spoken with Chase and gave him Lighting info.

Kevin called me again on 10/25/18. I told him I had not heard anything from Chase. Kevin called again today, 1/18/19, and said he was contacting your office to help get a light.

We have had some Metro Council people get lights for their areas. You would need to contact Jeffrey Brown with the Public Works Department. His phone number is 502 574-0065. They require the Council Person to pay for the light for 5 years and allocate the money to the city. Jeffrey Brown would be the person to also confirm that Sherry Hamilton's office did not allocate money for a light to be placed at 348 N 27th St.

I have attached a Lighting Brochure for you that shows the monthly rates and if you scroll down on the attachment you can see pictures of the lights we offer. I have also attached a map showing the approximate locations of the lights in the alley. The lights are highlighted in yellow and I have highlighted Kevin's address.
