CM Hollander / Kyle,

As part of the railroad permitting process, my contractor found out that RJC requires "Railroad Protective Liability Insurance". This was not known at the time of my estimating. That cost to the project is **\$5,775.00**. Can District 9 provide the extra funding for this change order?

Proof of Public Liability or Commercial Liability Insurance will be required. If project is within 50' of the railroad track, Railroad Protective Liability Insurance will be required also. R.J. Corman's policy does not provide for the option of adding a rider to its policy as a substitute for applicant's purchase of its own policy

Your RJC Entry Permit number should be included on your certificate. This agreement number will be assigned with application approval.
