

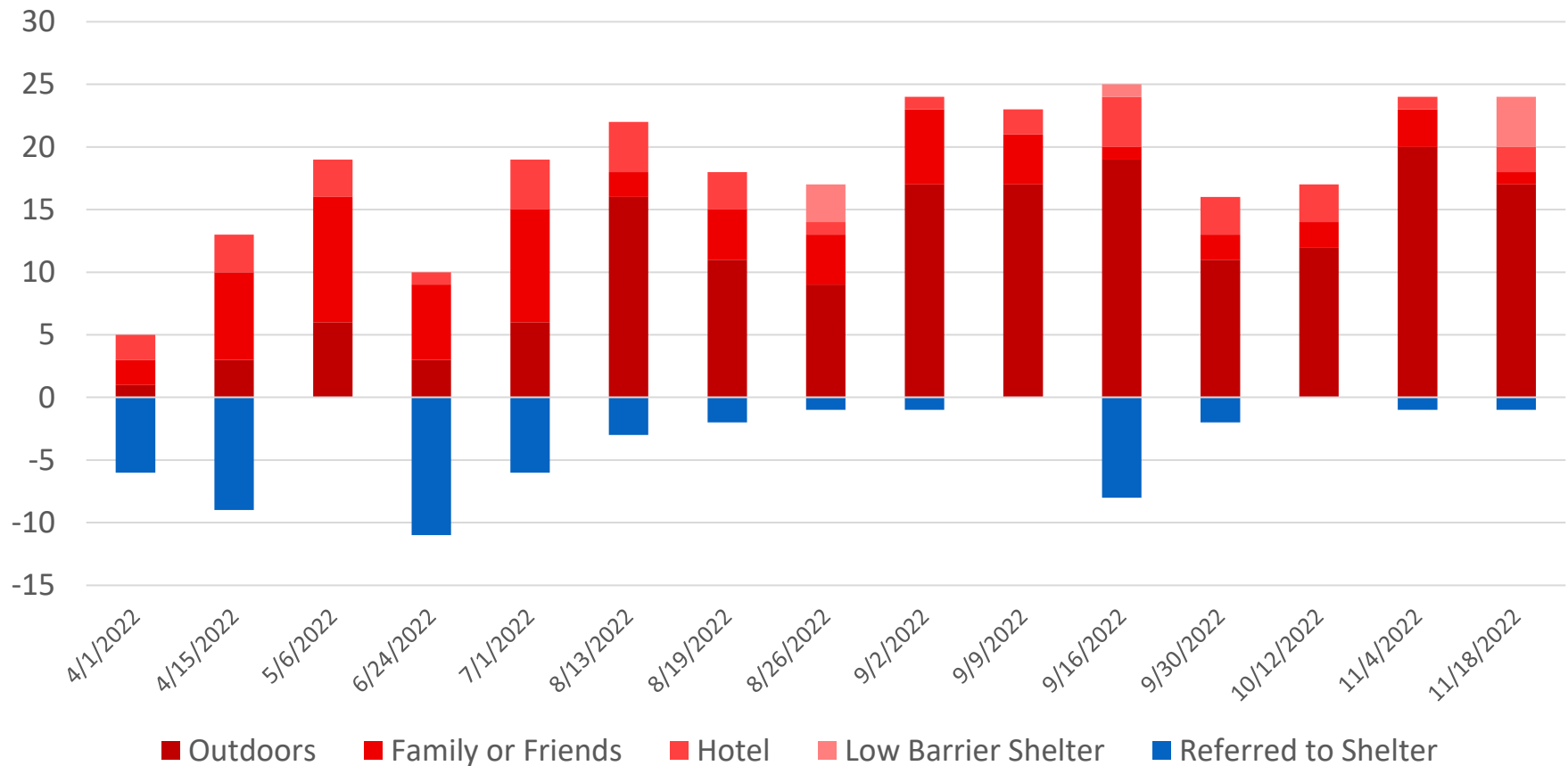

A Way Home

Through this program, families will be moved from unsheltered homelessness into a hotel for two months, during which they will be stabilized and provided with intensive case management and housing navigation. As they transition into permanent housing, the program will pay their initial housing deposit and rent for up to six months. Families qualifying for HUD-subsidized vouchers will receive a warm hand-off to those programs.

- \$6,600 for hotel (60 nights), case management, & meals
- \$1,000 for rental and utility arrears, utility deposit
- \$2,500 for furniture
- \$360 for transportation
- Deposit
- Up to 6 months rent

<p>Inclement Weather: This program will provide indoor low-barrier accommodations for individuals seeking temporary shelter during inclement winter weather, ensuring an emergency response in the event of a citywide State of Emergency. This budget supports up to 100 individuals for as many as 7 nights and will be added to HSD's budget of \$60,000.</p>
