

ORDINANCE NO. 227, SERIES 2018

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$10,000 FROM DISTRICT 15 NEIGHBORHOOD DEVELOPMENT FUNDS TO THE LOUISVILLE METRO POLICE DEPARTMENT TO FUND EXPENSES ASSOCIATED WITH LMPD'S PILOT PROGRAM, THE ADDICTION OUTREACH UNIT.

SPONSORED BY: COUNCIL MEMBER BUTLER

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT (THE COUNCIL) AS FOLLOWS:

**SECTION I:** The amount of \$10,000 is hereby appropriated from District 15 Neighborhood Development Funds to the Louisville Metro Police Department to fund expenses associated with LMPD's Pilot Program, the Addiction Outreach Unit.

**SECTION II:** The Council has determined that the funds requested in this Ordinance will be expended for a public purpose.

**SECTION III:** This grant is subject to the Council's Policies and Procedures as adopted and effective at the date of passage of this Ordinance.


**SECTION IV:** This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and approval.
