The rough-estimate for **guardrail, and striping for parking spaces** is **\$6,700.00**. Details are below:

- Per URS's estimate, Guardrail removal/replacement is approx.. \$2,000.00, plus guardrail-end-treatments, 4500.00 = \$6,500.00.
