1075 Garrs Ln Alley – there is a section of the alley which is concrete behind the apartments and is in reasonable shape (few cracks in the concrete here and there). The section behind 1075 Garrs is aspahlt and not in as good of shape (I assume that the apartments fixed their section of the alley at some point). I would reconstruct this portion only for now which is approximately 90'x15'. I estiamte this to be \$10,000.00. In the event you want to reconstruct the entire alley, I would remove the concrete and aspahlt and come back in with all concrete, that would be \$70,000.00.

Alley between Grand and Hall running from S 32nd St to Reynolds - in really bad shape, large pot holes and again has a parking lot connected to it for an appartment complex on a portion of the alley. I am quoting you a 12 inch reconstruction of the alley as I do not know what is below the current asphalt. At a minimum I would recommend a 4 inch mill and 4 inches of aspahlt be replaced. My estimate for this alley is \$55,000.00.

Alley Running from S 22nd st to S 23rd just north of Algonquin (Gregg intersects the alley) – is currently concrete and has inverted crown. The alley is cracked at the inverted crown throughout, but not terrible on variable displacement. I might recommend a few pannel replacement, but think that a full scale removal and replacement may be excessive. I would suggest putting in \$20-25k on this alley and we would replace the worst of the worst. Below are just a couple loations where that funding might be well spent.

Gregg Ave from Vorster to alley - Asphalt in okay shape, few apparent utility cuts here and there. Would recommend if funding, to mill and repave all of the roadway. I have that estimated at \$20,000.00.

Let me know if you might want me to quote something above differently.
