“OAKDALE NEIGHBORHOOD”

- 1.) 5<sup>th</sup> Street at Evelyn Ave – S.W. corner (at the empty lot) – Needs a pad.
- 2.) 5<sup>th</sup> Street at W. Whitney Ave – Place on the existing boarding pad opposite end from FH. – NO PAD NEEDED.
- 3.) 5<sup>th</sup> Street at Kenton Street – Place on the Kenton side – Needs a pad.
- 4.) Longfield Ave at Bellevue Ave – At 716 Longfield Ave – Needs a pad.
- 5.) Longfield Ave at Cliff Ave – At 900 Longfield Ave, behind the sidewalk – Needs a pad.
- 6.) Beecher Street at Warren Ave – S.W. corner, at Wyandotte Park – Needs a pad.
- 7.) Beecher Street at Peachtree Ave – At 1031 Beecher Street, on the Peachtree side – Needs a pad.
- 8.) Camden Ave at Bellevue Ave – At Church lot, replacing wire basket – Needs a pad.
- 9.) Henry Ave at Hathaway Ave – Close to stop sign, at empty lot across from MBS – Needs a pad.
- 10.) Dresden Ave at Warren Ave – N.E. corner, behind the sidewalk – Needs a pad.

- New Pad* 1.) The intersection at Cayuga Street, Bicknell Ave & Hazelwood Ave – N.W. corner – Needs a pad.
- 2.) Bicknell Ave & Wheeler Ave – S.E. corner – Needs a pad.
- New CAN* 3.) On Bicknell Ave, behind 4100 Taylor Blvd (The Family Health Center) – The south side of Bicknell Ave at the additional parking lot to the Family Health Center. (See map) – NO PAD NEEDED.
