After talking with CW Shanklin as well as Jeff Brown at Public Works, CW Shanklin would like to use her map funds on some or all of these projects

1. Lagoon Dr. from Rangeland Rd to Ailanthus Trail both the street as well as the curbs
2. The 100" or so of Yaupon Ln at the intersection of Yew lane and Yaupon Ln
3. Kilmer Blvd
4. Silver Leaf

While these four projects constitute more than the 50+50 in map funds, CW Shanklin would like to pass these projects on to Jeff Brown (or appropriate staff) at PW&A to evaluate for both need and cost effectiveness, with the full funds to be spent on the project/s they determine to be the best use of these funds according to need. If Jeff feels that a small amount of supplemental funds above the \$100,000 will create a better return, ie. if a second or third project can be completed with an additional 5 to 10 thousand (hypothetically) CW Shanlin might be willing to aid in that.
