Dan,

The project looks favorable per possibly applying for federal funding in the future. In order to do so, we would need some accurate cost estimates. I drove through here yesterday and noticed that this would not be an easy straight forward new sidewalk project. For starters, Manslick Road is a KYTC maintained roadway and any new project would have to be approved by District 5. I got a price from our engineering consultant for conducting a Phase 1 Study (Preliminary Engineering Study). Because of the perceived difficult nature of the project, I asked to them provide a "ramped-up" Phase 1 Study. That cost would be **\$25,000**. This study would yield all the potential costs associated with new infrastructure projects (Final Design, R/W, Utility Impacts and Construction). With these "Costs" in hand, we can then go apply for federal funding where the local costs would only be 20% of the total bill. The one problem with receiving federal funds is that it would take many, many years to complete the project.

Dan Lockett Jr here from District 15. I am emailing you to start a conversation about sidewalks along Manslick Rd. There is a development going in at 4801 Manslick Rd. (Mill Creek Development - Manslick Rd & Bluegrass Ave) The developer is the Marion Group. A group of us have started conversations with them. Yes, they will construct sidewalks to the end of their property on Manslick Rd. (Bluegrass Ave as well) What our group's question is can sidewalks extend from there on down to Gagel Ave if possible? This would be on the east side running south. I know this is a State Rd. I also know there are ROW/easement issues. My question right now is.....would this be possible?

This is an affordable housing project. With that, realistically there will be many walkers from this apartment complex to food sources being currently built at Manslick and Gagel. The need is huge!!! If no sidewalks there will be walkers getting off the developers sidewalk and either walk in an incredibly busy, hazardous Manslick Rd or right along it at a very dangerous curve. State Representative has had some preliminary talks with the State Transportation Department just to broach the subject.

So, just let me know your thoughts and general opinion. We are a long way away from any decisions but we are trying to get ahead of the game and gather information. As always I know this might all come down to \$money. Let's talk possibilities first. Thank you Sir and I look forward to hearing your thoughts. Take care!
