

ORDINANCE NO. _____, SERIES 2018

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$6,000 FROM NEIGHBORHOOD DEVELOPMENT FUNDS IN THE FOLLOWING MANNER: \$5,000 FROM DISTRICT 24; AND \$500 EACH FROM DISTRICTS 10 AND 15; THROUGH THE OFFICE OF MANAGEMENT AND BUDGET, TO THE COALITION FOR THE HOMELESS, INC. FOR PROGRAMMING EXPENSES ASSOCIATED WITH PROJECT STAND DOWN AND THE "GIVE-A-JAM" EVENT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT (THE COUNCIL) AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: The sum of \$6,000 is hereby appropriated from Neighborhood Development Funds in the following manner: \$5,000 from District 24; and \$500 each from Districts 10 and 15; through the Office of Management and Budget, to The Coalition for the Homeless, Inc. for programming expenses associated with Project Stand Down and the "Give-A-Jam" event.

SECTION II: The Council has determined the funds requested in this Ordinance will be expended for a public purpose.

SECTION III: This grant is subject to the Council's Policies and Procedures as adopted and effective at the date of passage of this Ordinance.

SECTION IV: This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and approval.
