Jeff,

As you stated below, Hillbrook Dr is a residential road. Louisville Metro Public Works doesn't typically stripe residential facilities due to the low vehicular volumes and speeds. In the requested vicinity Hillbrook Dr serves 256 vehicles in the AM peak and 286 vehicles in the PM peak. Additionally, accidents were reviewed for the past 3 years, there have only been 2 reported accidents in this section of roadway since January 2013. Both occurred in 2013 and neither of these accidents were related to the curves. Please understand, if Council's office funds this striping project LMPW will not be able to maintain it. It will either not be restriped or will have to be funded by an entity other than LMPW. An installation of this type is typically refreshed between one to four years depending on materials and site specific conditions. The project cost is estimated to be \$2,500 to stripe Hillbrook Dr from Breckenridge Ln to Esther Blvd / Laurelwood Ave. Please let me know if you have any questions or if you would like to discuss this matter further.
