AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$75,000 FROM NEIGHBORHOOD DEVELOPMENT FUNDS IN THE FOLLOWING MANNER: \$50,000 FROM DISTRICT 5 AND \$25,000 FROM DISTRICT 2, THROUGH DEVELOP LOUISVILLE, TO METRO HOUSING RESOURCE CENTER TO FUND THE EMERGENCY REPAIR PROGRAM FOR SENIORS AND INCOME QUALIFIED RESIDENTS.


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT (THE "COUNCIL") AS FOLLOWS:


**SECTION I:** The sum of \$75,000 is hereby appropriated from Neighborhood Development Funds in the following manner: \$50,000 from District 5 and \$25,000 from District 2, through Develop Louisville, to Metro Housing Resource Center to fund the Emergency Repair Program for seniors and income qualified residents.


**SECTION II:** The Council has determined the funds requested in this Ordinance will be expended for a public purpose.
