The following was discussed:

- Part of recapitalization and renovation to the Woodsmill Apartments property
- In exchange for the Interest rate being reduced to 0 percent and the maturity date extended, a principal payment should be made for the balance of Louisville Metro's loan for any surplus funds during refinancing will be paid back to Louisville Metro
- There will be a personal guarantee from Todd Clark and John Clark to sign the renewed obligation to Metro as individuals
- The modification agreement will reduce the accrued interest from May 31,
 2005 to current
- Estimated to be \$ 1,577,789.00
- The debt from now until end of term to zero percent is an additional \$1.3 Million dollars
- Background information about Woodsmill Apartments; specifically, location, rent and Area Median Income ("AMI") level
- Low income housing tax credit property, 535 units consisting of both one and two bedroom floor plans, Located off of South Poplar Level rd.
- Whether the original loan was home funds or Metro Government funds
- How much in total has been paid on the loan since 2005
- Zero has been paid on the loan since established since 2005
- Loan stands on a cash flow basis and there has been no surplus cash flow
- Seeking to get out from under the interest
- What Woodsmill Partners LLC. anticipates changing to make paying the overall loan amount possible
- Restructuring of the financing of the property and lowering of the interest rate will help create cash flow in order to pay of the entirety of the loan
- Renovations are being made to the property

- Turn-over rates
- Has three Louisville Metro loans that are currently outstanding. 1. of \$28,000.00, and the second and third within the \$30,000-40,000.00 range, however are not in the name of Woodsmill Partners LLC.
- What other properties does Woodsmill Partners LLC. have and/or develop in Louisville that might need financial assistance currently
- Woodsmill Partners LLC. does have other properties in Louisville but none need financial assistance at this time
