Tree Watering Regiment

By Erin Thompson, Urban Forestry Coordinator for City of Louisville, KY

- 1. At time of planting: After a tree has been properly planted in the ground it needs to be watered immediately.
- Year 1: The first year that the tree is in the ground it needs to be watered once a week so that it receives the equivalent of 1 inch of rainfall weekly from around mid-April to mid-September when temperature are in the high 70's and up. Make sure that the root zone of the tree gets plenty of access to the water (don't just apply water to one area but the whole area). The best method of watering is slow and even across the root zone-the reason that Gator Bags are often utilized. Make sure that the soil is damp not soggy.
 - **Adjust timing if hot weather starts or ends early.
 - ***If there is a rainfall event that produces 1 inch or greater rainfall, there is not a need to water the tree. One can always test the soil moisture by using a small trowel shovel to access the soil adjacent to the root zone at a depth of 2 inches. If the soil is dry, than water. If the soil is overly damp to soggy, than hold off—over watering a tree can damage it too.
- 3. Year 2: Water the tree by-weekly from mid-April to mid-September.
- 4. Year 3: Once a month from mid-April to mid-September.

Memorandum of Agreement

Between the

Louisville/Jefferson County Metro Government, acting by and through Operation Brightside Incorporated

And

The Young Mens Christian Association of Greater Louisville, acting by and through its Southwest Family YMCA

Pertaining to the Planting and Maintaining Trees

This Memorandum of Agreement is made and entered by and between the Louisville/Jefferson County Metro Government, acting through Operation Brightside Incorporated (hereafter referred to as Brightside), a Kentucky 501 ©(3) corporation, with the address at Metro Hall, 6th Floor, 527 West Jefferson Street, Louisville, KY 40202; and the Young Mens Christian Association of Greater Louisville, acting by and through its Southwest Family YMCA (hereafter referred to as SW YMCA), 2800 Fordhaven Road, Louisville, KY 40214.

1. Services:

Brightside shall plant 30 trees in the right of way along the northwest side Fordhaven Road from 2901 to 3221 and on the publicly owned property (Louisville Water Company) of the SW YMCA at 2800 Fordhaven Road. Brightside will provide watering bags to the SW YMCA. SW YMCA shall assume the care and maintenance of all plantings for a period of three years as per the recommendations of the Louisville Metro Urban Forestry Coordinator. Said recommendations include weekly watering from mid-April to mid-September in year 1; biweekly watering and pruning from mid-April to Mid-September in year 2; watering and pruning every 4 weeks from June to September in year 3.

2. Cost:

Brightside will provide and plant the tree(s) at no cost to SW YMCA. Brightside will provide watering bags at no cost to SW YMCA. SW YMCA will maintain such trees at its own expense.

3. Conflict of Interest:

The parties certify, by the signatures of duly authorized Representatives on this Agreement, that they are legally entitled to enter into this MOA and that they shall not be violating, either directly to indirectly, any conflict of interest statute of the Commonwealth of Kentucky by the performance of this agreement.

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4. Entire Agreement:

This agreement is the entire agreement and understanding of the parties with respect to the subject matter set forth herein and this Agreement supersedes any and all prior and contemporaneous oral or written agreements or understandings between the parties that are not embodied in this Agreement. This Agreement cannot be amended, modified, or supplemented in any respect except by a subsequent written agreement duly executed by all of the parties hereto.

5. Successors:

This agreement shall be binding upon and insure to the benefit of the parties hereto and their respective heirs, successors and assigns.

6. Severability:

If any court of competent jurisdiction holds any provision of this Agreement unenforceable, such provision shall be modified to the extent required to make it enforceable, consistent with the spirit and intent of this Agreement. If such a provision cannot be so modified, the provision shall be deemed separable from the remaining provisions of this agreement and shall not affect any other provision hereunder.

7. Warranties:

Brightside makes no warranties, express or implied, including, without limitation, any implied warranty of merchantability or fitness for a particular purpose or implied warranty arising out of course of performance, course of dealing, or usage of trade.
