Illegal Dumping vs Illegal Setout

They appear the same but are handled differently

- Placing junk/items in or on another persons property or dumpster
- Enforced under 51.500
- Placing junk/items out on their own property for collection outside of normal collection schedule
- Enforced under 51.405

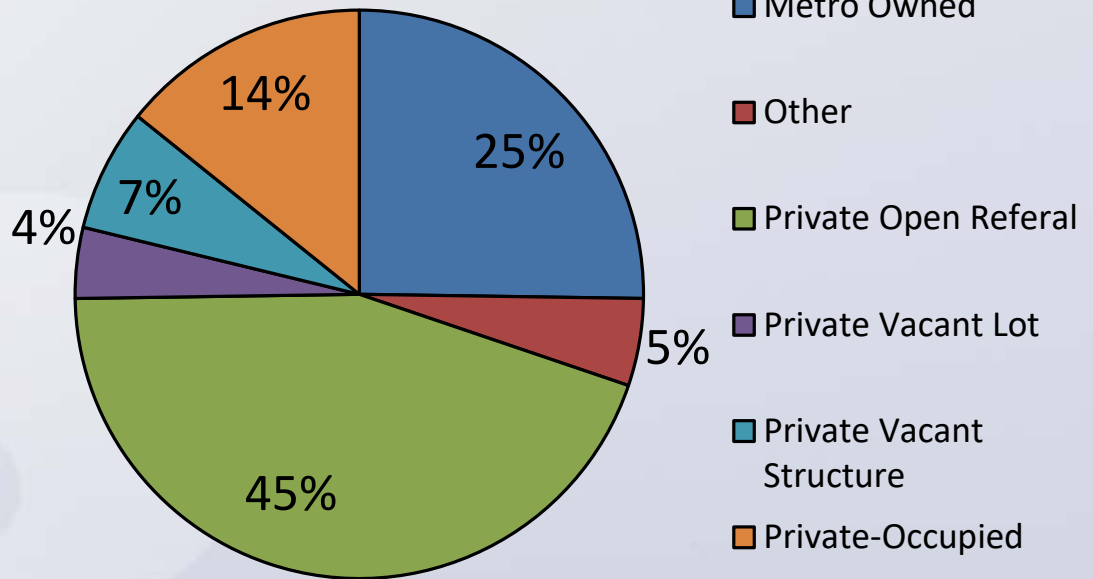

Junk Collection Process

- LMC0 Chapter 51.405 (G)
 - No limit on items but all must come from home where it is setout
 - No construction & demolition materials including but not limited to lumber, shingles, gutters, siding, concrete slabs
 - No more than four (4) tires or any automotive parts
 - Tree limbs must be no longer than 4' or 4" in diameter and less than 60 pounds
 - No loose debris. Must be boxed or bagged
 - No hazardous materials
 - Setout Friday before and must be out before 6 am of Monday of the collection week.

Definition of Construction & Demolition Debris Waste

- LMC0 Chapter 51: Waste resulting from the construction, remodeling, repair and demolition of structures or roads

Collection Process

- Supervisor drives each street to gauge compliance of loads setout for collection
- Loads that have improper materials are marked with orange spray paint
- Sticker placed on door to notify resident
- Enforcement Unit is notified to follow up

What is being dumped?

- Construction and demolition waste
- Used tires
- Household bulk waste
- Tree debris
- Garbage
- Boats/Trailers

Illegal Dumping Prevention

Barriers: the single most effective measure to prevent dumping is to ensure access is controlled.

- Fences (see through)
- Post
- Berms
- Ditches
- Concrete barriers

Lighting and visibility: The second measure is to create a location that makes dumpers uncomfortable.

- Add lighting
- Remove brush and vegetation
- Demolish abandoned/vacant buildings or garages

Illegal Dumping Prevention

Keep it Clean

- People dump where they think people don't care
- Remove dumped items because a little junk becomes a lot of junk very quickly

Visibility

- People dump where they can't be seen. Remove obstacles such as fences and brush
- Put some light on the area

Record and Report

- Use cell phone cameras or home/business surveillance cameras
- Call MetroCall 911 and 311
- You can remain anonymous

Don't be part of the Problem

- Always get a dump receipt before paying someone that hauled your waste
- Can you prove you disposed of it properly? If we find your waste dumped and you can't prove it then you can get fined.
