Jared,

As of today, the 100W HPS Open bottoms cost \$11.93 per month. There can be periodic rate increases. Two surcharges are added to each light, Electric Fuel Adjustment and an Environmental surcharge.

I have attached an example of the surcharges.

So, the price for 38 lights for 5 years, as of today, will be \$28,659.60.

$\$11.93 + .64 = \12.57
 $\$12.57 \times 38 \text{ lights} = \477.66
 $\$477.66 \times 60 \text{ months (5 years)} = \$28,659.60$
