

ORDINANCE NO. 039, SERIES 2018

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT CODE OF ORDINANCES CHAPTERS 115.360(C), 115.360(D), AND 115.369(E) RELATING TO MOBILE FOOD UNIT VENDORS.

SPONSORED BY: COUNCIL MEMBERS HAMILTON AND LEET

WHEREAS, Louisville/Jefferson County Metro Government (“Louisville Metro Government”) enacted Louisville/Jefferson County Metro Government Code of Ordinances (“LMCO”) §§ 115.360(C) and 115.360(D) on May 18, 2009 and § 115.369(E) on November 17, 2011 relating to the distance from various businesses which mobile vendors can sell or vend in Louisville Metro;


WHEREAS, Troy King and Robert Martin (“Plaintiffs”) filed a lawsuit against Louisville Metro Government challenging the constitutionality of proximity restrictions contained in LMCO 115.360;

WHEREAS, Louisville/Jefferson County Metro Council hereby repeals LMCO §§ 115.360(C), 115.360(D), and 115.369(E) to address this concerns raised in this action.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: LMCO §§ 115.360(C), 115.360(D), and 115.369(E) are hereby repealed.


SECTION II: This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and approval.
