This was a joint project between TARC and District 22 who split the cost 80% TARC, 20% District 22. (Total Project Cost: \$37,240. TARC Cost: \$29,792.16. D22 Cost: \$7,448.04.) This funded new TARC stops, improved safety features at the intersection of Bardstown Road at Cedar Look Drive. The final cost increased, and Public Works is requesting an additional \$737.83. This will go along with the original amount of \$7,448.04 which D22 contributed in November of 2020. This amount came from Fee in Lieu sidewalk funds, account #:8101 410 8211 148522 821344. CIF funds will be used to add the additional \$737.83.


