

Kenwood Hil Road – from W Kenwood to East Kenwood \$60,000

Laughlin Ave – From W Kenwood to the dead end \$50,000

Bluegrass Ave – from Taylor Blvd to Southern Parkway \$225,000

- PAV

- Seneca Trail – from South 3rd Street to Southside Drive \$56,000
- W. Kenwood Way – from S 2nd Street to S. 1st Street & also S. 2nd Street to the dead end. (paving beside Americana Community Center is the priority, previously requested just getting in all in the same email.) 2nd to dead end - \$32,000, 1st and 2nd \$25,000 - PAV (partial)
- Phillips Lane from Preston Highway to Crittenden Drive (this may have already been estimated by PW for internal reasons) Do not resurface, I saw KYTC has a project to widen Philips from 2 to 4 lanes. I am trying to confirm whether or not this will happen or not.
