Vicki,

The drainage issue at 7425 Old North Church has been inspected and an estimate has been prepared. The estimate is in the email just below.

After speaking with James Pennington, Engineer II and John Akridge, Inspector II it has been determined that this drainage issue is the result of a combination of the road itself having a very low grade (0.1-0.4%) so that the road is almost flat and the curb needing to be replaced. Simply replacing the curb will not completely eliminate the issue. Repaving this section of the street in order to improve the grade doesn't seem to be an option at this time due to the expense and since it was just repaved. However if you should choose to replace the curb we are more than happy to oblige.

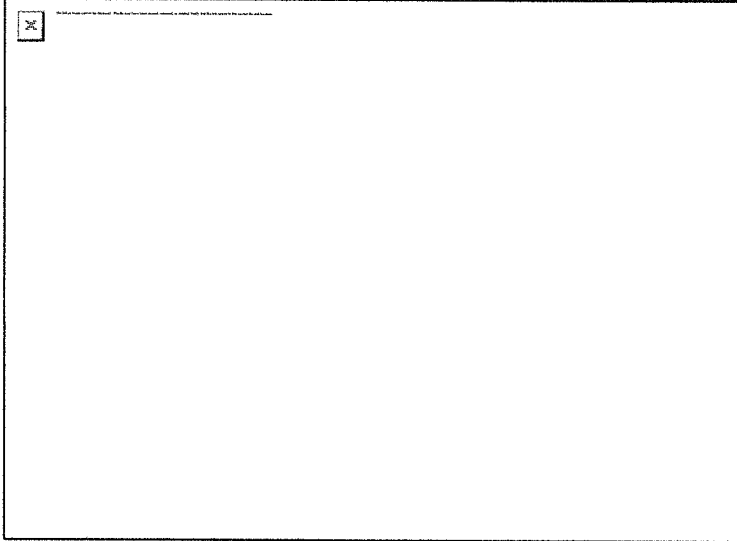
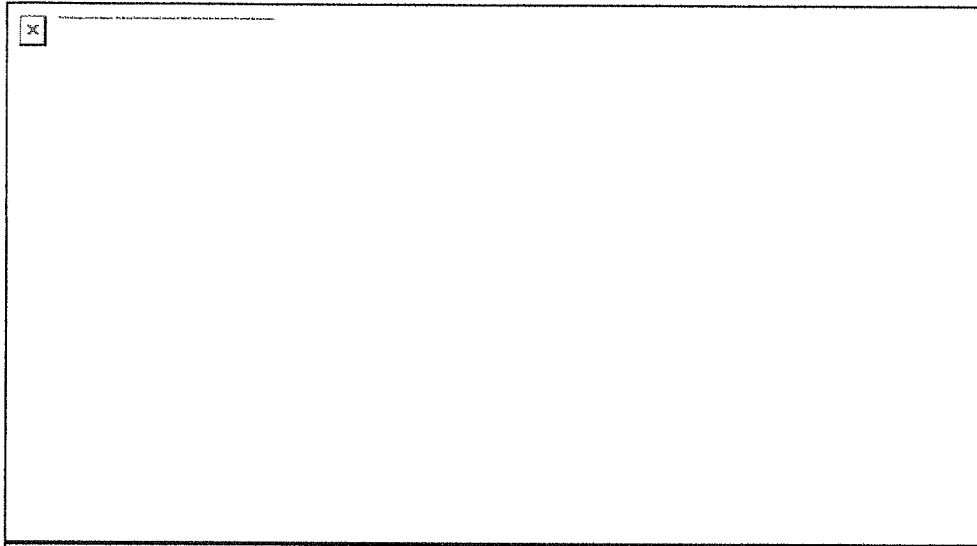

Vicki,

I made a site visit earlier today during the rain to 7425 Old North Church. There is curb on both sides of the road and water runs from the center out. The street was not built up diverting water across the street. The curb along Old North Church is flat and has settled in some places causing small amounts of water to stand. In addition, water doesn't drain as quickly in flatter areas. The curb in front of 7425 has settled slightly, but was still flowing when I was on site. Below are two pictures, one from before paving and the other from today. As you can see, water ponded in the area prior to paving but seems to dissipate soon after a rain event. The only solution would be to replace the curb. However, if this section gets replaced, there are several more along Old North Church that have similar situations. If you need anything more or have further questions, please let me know.
