

ORDINANCE NO. _____, SERIES 2017

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$4,500 FROM NEIGHBORHOOD DEVELOPMENT FUNDS IN THE FOLLOWING MANNER: \$1,500 FROM DISTRICT 15; \$1,000 EACH FROM DISTRICTS 13 AND 21; AND \$500 EACH FROM DISTRICTS 9 AND 25; THROUGH THE OFFICE OF MANAGEMENT AND BUDGET, TO THE FOOD LITERACY PROJECT AT OXMOOR FARM, INC. FOR EXPENSES ASSOCIATED WITH IMPLEMENTING ITS FIELD-TO-FORK PROGRAM AT IROQUOIS URBAN FARM.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT (THE COUNCIL) AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: The sum of \$4,500 is hereby appropriated from Neighborhood Development Funds in the following manner: \$1,500 from District 15; \$1,000 each from Districts 13 and 21; and \$500 each from Districts 9 and 25; through the Office of Management and Budget, to The Food Literacy Project at Oxmoor Farm, Inc. for expenses associated with implementing its Field-to-Fork Program at Iroquois Urban Farm.

SECTION II: The Council has determined the funds requested in this Ordinance will be expended for a public purpose.

SECTION III: This grant is subject to the Council's Policies and Procedures as adopted and effective at the date of passage of this Ordinance.

SECTION IV: This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and approval.
